

## University of Michigan Health-Sparrow Mobile Health Clinic

University of Michigan Health-Sparrow is truly grateful for Dean Transportation's generous support. We are proud to provide this update on the Mobile Health Clinic (MHC) and share the vital impact your partnership has made within the community.

From its humble beginnings in 2016, the MHC has grown into a new, reliable bus that is fulfilling a critical role in the health of the community. In 2023, the clinic welcomed 174 patients and the number has been steadily growing each year. Last year the MHC served 534 patients and is predicted to serve a similar number of patients this year.

In October 2025, the UMH-Sparrow Medical Group will be joining the Mobile Health Clinic to increase its community presence and the numbers of patients served. Currently, the MHC travels to one community event per week, with plans to increase to three to four weekly events and expand the clinic hours. Future plans also include partnering with the medical department for point of care testing to receive rapid test results.
